ARTICLE I-DEFINITION OF JUNKYARD

JUNKYARD A place or establishment where articles that have outlived their usefulness in their original form are bought and sold to be used either in their original form or to be converted into a product of a different kind by some manufacturing process.

ARTICLE II-OPERATION OR ESTABLISHMENT OF JUNKYARD PROHIBITED

Any person, firm or corporation who or which establishes, operates, maintains or permits to be established, operated or maintained a junkyard within the corporate limits of the Town of Houston shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

ARTICLE III-VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

- A. Any person, firm or corporation who or which violates any of the provisions above shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined for the first offense not less than \$50 nor more than \$100, and for each subsequent like offense shall be fined not less than \$100 nor more than \$200, in addition to the costs of prosecution.
- B. For the purposes of this chapter, each day that an offense defined above continues shall constitute a separate offense.
