ARTICLE I- APPLICABILITY

It shall be unlawful to accumulate two (2) or more of the following: unlicensed motor vehicles, including, but not limited to, utility/boat trailers, campers or motorhomes or unregistered boats or to maintain a scrap heap within the corporate limits of Houston.

Storage of unlicensed motor vehicles, boat trailers and self-propelled camper, camper trailer or boats will not be permitted in the front yard.

ARTICLE II-NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Any owner, person, firm, association, or corporation violating any of this provision of this Chapter shall be notified in writing to have the unlicensed motor vehicles or scrap heap removed within thirty (30) days from such notice.

ARTICLE III-FAILURE TO REMEDY-ACTION BY TOWN

Upon the failure of the property owner or tenant to correct the violation within thirty (30) days of said notice, the Town Council and/or his/her designee may proceed to have the motor vehicle(s) or scrap heap removed or otherwise remedied at the expense of the owner of said property and, when completed, a bill for the cost of removal and an administrative fee of \$500.00 thereby incurred as determined by the Town Council in the name of the Town of Houston, as soon as convenient thereafter, be presented to the owner of said property or the tenant of said owner.

ARTICLE IV-FAILURE OF OWNER TO PAY TOWN-COLLECTION BY TOWN

If the bill so presented by the Town Council and/or his/her designee on behalf of the Town of Houston shall not be paid within thirty (30) days following delivery, the Town Council of the Town of Houston may institute an action in the corporate name in any court of competent jurisdiction in the State of Delaware for the collection of the debt to collect the same in a manner now or hereafter provided for the collection of judgments in the State of Delaware or he or she may be proceed by any other method provided in the Charter of the Town of Houston for the collection of debts due the Town of Houston.
